

The following change(s) are effective:

.0103 (b) (3) Interview. The inmate is informed of the purpose of the committee meeting and is interviewed in order to obtain the inmate's ideas, opinions, attitudes, preferences, and other additional facts. The inmate is allowed a reasonable opportunity to present comments and to ask relevant questions at the conclusion of the interview by the committee members. If the inmate is declared developmentally disabled, a certified developed disabled case manager shall be assigned to serve as a representative before all classification and control hearings. The assigned representative will write a statement on DC-138-B form concerning the hearing representation and give it to the committee chair person.

.0108 APPEALS

The inmate appeal process on custody classification actions shall follow the Division's Policy and Procedure, G.0300, Administrative Remedy Procedures.
