

.1505 (d) now reads: Immediate medical treatment is required following a use of force incident. Photographs will be taken at the facility as soon as is possible after the completion of the medical screening that shows a full view of the inmate's face and body in order to document the inmate's physical condition. If the taking of the photograph to document the inmate's physical condition causes a potential risk of injury to the staff or inmate then the Officer-In-Charge shall determine that the photograph will not be taken and will document that determination on the Incident Report.
